WGL Energy Services, Inc. (WGL Energy) is providing this Environmental Information for Electric Power Supply Service in accordance with the District of Columbia Public Service Commission’s 15 DCMR Section 4201. Power plants can generate electricity from a number of different fuel sources, resulting in different emissions. WGL Energy reports fuel sources and emissions to customers twice annually, allowing customers to compare data among the companies providing electricity service to the District of Columbia. When WGL Energy specific emissions and energy source (fuel mix) data vary from the PJM Interconnection average, it is due to the benefit of additional purchases of Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) as per the Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard (RPS) mandated annually by the District of Columbia. *PJM Interconnection is a regional transmission organization (RTO) that coordinates the movement of wholesale electricity in all or parts of 13 states and the District of Columbia. The WGL Energy wind percentages shown correspond to PJM values only.

Large Commercial Customers: The fuel mix and emissions disclosure above includes the Environmental Information for your Electric Power Supply Service from the local PJM grid. If you purchase national wind power, sourced from wind farms outside of PJM, your wind power purchase is not reflected in the table above.

Small Commercial and Residential Customers: If you purchase National WindPower from WGL Energy a portion of your wind power is sourced from wind farms within the PJM grid. Small commercial and residential customers refer to the 3.5% or 5% wind column, respectively, for your fuel mix information.
